



Aylestone School Homework Detention Policy

Homework is vital in students consolidating knowledge already learnt in the classroom. It also provides for an opportunity in researching topics already introduced or topics that are soon to be covered.

Homework also develops the student's independence, their love of learning, and their commitment to their studies.

Students who complete all homework will as a result give themselves every chance of reaching their potential. Completing homework will also provide them with the opportunity for earning House Points in school.

Due to the widely recognised benefits of completing homework, and the school recognising its importance, we have introduced a policy in which states that if a student fails to complete Homework on 3 separate occasions during one half term, then the student will be required to attend 4 x 60 minute compulsory Homework Detentions.

These detentions will be supervised by members of the Senior Leader Team. At every detention, the student is required to bring with them any current or outstanding homework. If they have no current or outstanding homework, then they are required to bring with them any independent learning tasks or revision tasks. The student **MUST NOT** arrive without work to complete.

A student fails to complete Homework on at least 3 occasions within the same half term

They will attend 4 x 60 minute after school detentions over a 2-week period. These will take place on two evenings each week.

Attendance at the detention

YES and the student works without any behaviour incidents.

Leads to the students completing homework, and/or completing independent studies towards their subjects.

YES but either the student does not work or has a behaviour incident.

An extra date is added to the student's detention list, and parents are notified via email.

NO (with or without reason)

Parents contacted via telephone and via email (if necessary) and an additional day is added to the detention register for that student.

If a student acquires another three C1's for Lack of Homework within that same Half Term, they are then served with an additional four detentions. Detentions can be carried over into the next half term.
